

Level 4 Certificate in Deafblind Interpreting (Manual)

Aims

To develop the necessary skills to interpret for deafblind people using deafblind manual.

Duration: 6 days in 3 blocks, assessment on day 7

Objectives

Participants will:

- Improve deafblind manual skills to 40 wpm
- Understand and practice verbatim interpreting
- Develop paraphrasing skills and practice their use
- Understand the different situations in which interpreters work
- Develop a professional attitude to interpreting
- Understand the significance of a Code of Practice, Complaints Procedure and be able to implement their use.

Course facilitators will include deafblind members who are skilled manual users

Appropriate for

Holders of the CACDP Communication and Guiding skills certificate whose manual speed is 30 wpm or above. It is necessary to have a qualification in English language to participate in this course. This course is aimed at people who will pursue a career working with deaf and deafblind people.
